新法例

- 為提高道路安全水平,政府實施 新法例,禁止司機在車輛行駛時 使用手提式流動電話,或其他同類 無綫電通訊設備。
- ■由2000年7月1日起,司機在 車輛行駛時,不論是否與他人 通話,都不可手持電話,或將電 話夾在頭及肩膀間。





為甚麼要實施新法例?

- 駕車時使用流動電話,會分散司機的 注意力及影響他的駕駛表現,尤其在 緊急或突發情況時,會影響司機的 反應。
- ■為確保安全,不要在駕車時使用流動電話,或其他通訊設備。

何時實施這項法例?

- ■由2000年7月1日起,禁止司機在車輛行駛時使用手提式流動電話。
- ■由2001年7月1日起,禁止司機在車輛行駛時使用其他同類型手提式通訊設備,包括無綫電通話器。

刑罰

■ 違規者最高可被罰款二千元。

安全提示

- ■駕車時不要使用流動電話。
- 假如你想打電話或接聽來電,應該 先把汽車停在安全的地方,或要求 同車乘客代勞。
- 如果你在駕車時確實需要使用流動 電話,你應該在車上裝設免提式 裝置。

A new law

- To enhance road safety, a new law will be introduced to ban the use of hand-held mobile phones or similar telecommunications equipment by drivers while vehicles are in motion.
- From July I, 2000, motorists will be prohibited from using hand-held mobile phones, or holding phones between the head and shoulder, whether communicating or not, while their vehicles are in motion.





Why is it needed?

- Using a mobile phone while driving distracts drivers and affects driving performance, in particular reaction time in emergency or unexpected situations.
- For safety's sake, keep your hands on the steering wheel. Don't phone and drive.

When does the new law take effect?

- The use of hand-held mobile phones by drivers while vehicles are in motion will be prohibited from July I, 2000.
- The use of other similar hand-held telecommunications equipment, including radiophones, by drivers while vehicles are in motion will be prohibited from July I, 2001.

Penalty

A breach of the new law can lead to a maximum fine of \$2,000.

Safety tips

- Do not use mobile phones while driving.
- If you need to make a call or answer the phone, stop at a safe place or ask a passenger to make a call or answer the phone for you.
- Motorists who have a real need to use mobile phones while driving should install a hands-free kit in their vehicles.
