

放下無線電 安全駕駛可實現



- 為促進道路安全，法例規定司機在車輛行駛時不可使用手提式流動電話。
- 由2001年7月1日起，這項禁制將延伸到所有其他手提式無線電通訊設備，包括無線電通話器及對講機等。違規者最高可被罰款二千元。
- 如果你確實有需要在駕車時使用無線電通訊設備，便應使用免提式裝置，並將通話時間盡量縮短。

Put down the radio phones now...



- To enhance road safety, drivers are prohibited from using mobile phones while their vehicles are in motion.
- From July 1, 2001, this prohibition will be extended to all other hand-held telecommunications equipment including radio phones and walkie-talkies. Those who fail to comply will be subject to a maximum fine of \$2,000.
- Motorists who have a real need to use telecommunications equipment while driving should make use of hands-free kits and keep their conversations brief.

This leaflet is for general reference only. The relevant legislation is set out in regulation 42(1)(g) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations (Cap.374 sub. leg.).
