Penalties on Minimum Driving Disqualification Period Proportion of alcohol in a person's breath, blood or urine	Minimum Driving Disqualification Period	
	First Conviction	Subsequent Conviction
Tier 1 : If it exceeds the prescribed limit but is less than 35mcg/80mg/107mg of alcohol in 100ml of breath / blood / urine respectively	6 months	2 years
Tier 2 : If it exceeds Tier 1 but is less than 66mcg / 150mg / 201mg of alcohol in 100ml of breath/blood/urine respectively	1 year	3 years
Tier 3 : If it exceeds Tier 2	2 years	5 years

The minimum disqualification periods for the following drink-driving related offences are also set at **Tier 3**:

- (a) Failure to provide specimens of breath for screening breath tests without reasonable excuse;
- (b) Failure to provide specimens of breath, blood or urine for analysis; and
- (c) Driving a motor vehicle under the influence of drink or drugs to such extent that is incapable of proper control of vehicles.
