




Before Go Out









2. Check the wheelchair and make sure it is safe to use.



3. If using electric wheelchair, check whether the batteries have sufficient energy for the whole journey.



4. Don't use wheelchair under the influence of alcohol or drugs.


Other



Pay attention to the quality of batteries during usage. Electricity may leak or batteries may overheat, particularly during charging, which may cause fire.
